## PARKING

Two parking spots are provided with your cabin rental. We also have additional parking in our main parking lot for any guests or visitors you may invite. We can also accommodate RVs but do not provide septic or any type of hook up on the property. For a daily RV rate, please contact the Eagles Crossing Store.

## DRIVING ON THE COURSE

Driving personal cars on the course is strictly prohibited.

We do offer **Golf Cart Rentals** and you must be 18 or older. Our Golf Carts were specially built for Eagles Crossing and each cart has been upgraded for a smooth ride in rough terrain. Golf Carts may not be driven to any remote areas of the property.

**Polaris Ranger Rentals** are for all off-road riding on literally miles of trails through 400+ acres of pristine property.

Golf Carts and Polaris Rangers can be rented at the Eagles Crossing Store.

## **INVITING ADDITIONAL GUESTS**

We encourage you to invite others out during your stay. We welcome small gatherings that are restricted to 5 people in total. Any extra overnight visitors must be approved in advance and will incur an extra fee as set out in our online rates.

It is the responsibility of the renter to ensure that any visitor also complies with our House Safety Rules.

## **SMOKING AND VAPING**

Please no smoking or vaping in the cabin. We ask that you please step outside to the porch and close the door to prevent smoke from lingering into the cabin.

There is also an ashtray on the ledge of the porch so that you can dispose of your cigarette safely. Rural fires can literally burn a place down way before the Fire Department arrives on scene. So please make sure all cigarettes are put out completely.

## **IN CASE OF RAIN**

Umbrellas are located in the closet of the cabin in the event of rain.

## **PETS**

No Pets are allowed. We can, however, help you locate a sitter outside of our property to care for your pet while you are here visiting. Please inquire at the Eagles Crossing Store for more information.

## **CONVENIENCE ITEMS**

Food, drinks and a variety of other convenience items including discs, clothing, sunscreen, toiletries, etc., are available at the Eagles Crossing Store and Pro Shop.

## ACCIDENTAL BREAKAGE

Accidents happen all the time... That's life!

We kindly request that you report any accidental breakage or damage that happens so that we can either replace it, fix it or clean up safely for you. In the event that damage to the property or contents is not covered by our insurance or it exceeds your security deposit, the cost to replace or repair will be billed to the guest.

## LOST AND FOUND

If you lose any personal belonging while on the property, please check the Eagles Crossing Store where we keep our "Lost and Found" items. If you've lost a disc on the course, please check the store as discs found on the course are returned by other players and also found daily by our groundskeepers. ## RURAL DRAINS

Please do not flush any sanitary items or baby wipes down the commode. Stopped up drains can be a real issue in rural America! We also encourage you to turn on the bathroom fan as you shower so the walls do not become wet from condensation.

## ELECTRICAL OUTAGE

If the lights go out for whatever reason, there is a full oil lantern and lighter above the cabinet area in the bedroom. A small flashlight is also placed on the kitchen counter near the door.

## BUGS AND PESTS

Most of Eagles Crossing is set in natural terrain so you are bound to run into bugs and pests along the way... From ticks, chiggers and mosquitos to buffalo gnats and snakes. Prevention is the key! And watching where you step when it comes to snakes! Bug Sprays can be found in the store along with itch and sting relief items that will help you heal. A tick removal tool is also located in your bathroom vanity.

## CABIN AMENITIES (cont...)

**CHARCOAL GRILL:** It is located directly outside the cabin. Charcoal can be purchased in the Eagles Crossing Store or you might want to check beneath the sink as other guests leave extra charcoal behind for others to use.

**USB PORTS:** Located on both nightstands in the bedroom at the back of each. A few spare charging cords are in the top drawer of the nightstands. Different types of charging cords are also sold in our Eagles Crossing Store and Pro Shop.

**TV:** Using the remote, the red button turns the TV on and off. Roku Streaming is installed for your enjoyment. There are streaming channels to choose from as well as news and the like.

**TOWELS:** Cabins are stocked with 6 bath towels, 6 hand towels and 6 face cloths. The small towels on the kitchen counter are provided for cleaning discs, shoes or any other clean up needed. We request that our bath and body towels not be used for cleaning discs. Towels are stored in the cabinet to the left of the refrigerator. For those longer stays, if you're in need of additional towels and linens, please let us know and we will bring them to your cabin and take any linens no longer needed back to the laundry. We would appreciate placing wet towels on the shower floor upon your departure.

**SOFA BED:** Sleeps 2. Directions for use are stored beneath the seat cushion. The bed is dressed and includes 2 pillows.

## THERMOSTAT CHANGES

Simply press the up or down arrow and watch the temperature number change on the digital display. Lift your finger off the arrow when you find the right number for your comfort then press Hold. It might be necessary to switch from A/C to Heat as temperature changes rapidly in Missouri.

## WINDOW SHADES

We think you'll like these window shades as they are room darkening and easy to use. If you want to sleep in, you're going to love these window shades! We ask that you be gentle when moving them up and down. Simply hold the handle in the middle of each shade and gently move it up or down and the shade will follow accordingly. Please always use the handle and not the shade itself so the oil residue from your fingers does not stain the window shade.

## SOFA BED

First create some room for the bed to pull out by moving the coffee table to the side next to the drape like a long end table. You can also upend the table so that it is standing on end if you wish to create more room in the cabin. We do not recommend upending the table if you have children in the cabin. Remove the cushions and stack them on the table or anywhere out of the way. You will then see labels that guide you to pull the bed up and out of the sofa. The bed is already dressed with sheets, blankets and 2 pillows.

## DISPOSING OF TRASH

A trashcan is provided beneath the kitchen sink and a small can in the bathroom and bedroom. If you are here on an extended stay, simply place your trash in the bags provided on the porch and it will be picked up for removal. Extra can liners or trash bags are stored in the bottom of each trashcan so you can easily replace the liner as you empty the trash.

## ACTIVITIES FOR CHILDREN AND ADULTS

We welcome children whole-heartedly but please note that parents have full responsibility of ensuring their children are supervised and safe at all times.

There are quite a few fun activities that are simply included with your cabin rental so please enjoy the property!

Taking a trek through the **Dinosaur Park in Jurassic Glade** and small hike through our mini **Africa Safari** will provide you with fun photo opportunities.

Walking through the **Organic Garden** can also be fun for kids! Plants are marked so children can learn what each plant provides while they walk around the garden. If Kathy or Missy are working the garden, they are always happy to help children learn how to harvest (especially strawberries that they can simply pick and eat!). So, come on up if you see them working in the garden!

**Fishing, hiking, horse shoes, washers, corn hole** and **kayaking** are also available. You can inquire at the Eagles Crossing Store for more information. There are 9 fully stocked lakes on the property and all can be fished but one. **The Waterfall** on the property has an area where the Koi fish come up and visit so you will find No Fishing signs posted at The Waterfall. Fishing Pole Rental and live bait is available in the Eagles Crossing Store.

And our **driving and putting ranges** are also available for all to enjoy!

## **FIRE EXTINGUISHERS**

A fire extinguisher is located beneath the sink. To put out a small fire on the stove, there is a can of fire spray beneath the kitchen sink, too. Just pop the lid, point and spray. To put out a larger fire, use the large extinguisher. Follow directions to pull the pin, hold down the handle and simply point it at the fire.

## **ASSISTANCE**

Please let us know if there is any assistance or help you might need while visiting with us. Extra pillows or towels can be brought to your cabin. There is an ice machine located on the left as you enter the Eagles Crossing Store and Pro Shop.

## **CHECK OUT**

Check out time is 10am. We ask our guests to inquire the morning of departure to determine if a late check out is possible. There are times that we can accommodate an hour if we know the next guest is a late check in.

All check outs after 11am will incur additional charges that are 50% of the daily rate and a check out after 2pm will incur charges for a full daily rate since there is simply not enough time to clean the room for another guest to stay the same day.

Before checking out, please remove all personal items including any groceries you might have brought with you. We would truly appreciate leaving the cabin as clean as possible.

If you can spare a moment as you leave, please sign our guest book as we would love to hear from you.
